Our "Focus Five"

North Somerset Liberal Democrats will prioritise these five areas in the new council to deliver for local people:

Children and Young People - Making North Somerset the best place to grow up

- Create timed 20mph zones around all schools, supported by the 20's Plenty safety campaign
- Improving our special education needs and disabilities service by increasing Special Educational Needs and Disability, and Mental Health Capacity within North Somerset.

Crime and Community Safety - Investing in a safer North Somerset

- Establish a Crime Prevention Fund for all wards
- Invest in ward-level social prescribing to tackle loneliness and isolation

Economy and Jobs - Delivering green and inclusive economic growth

- Drive investment in towns and villages across North Somerset to increase job opportunities for locals and expand the number of available apprenticeships and training opportunities
- Supporting High Streets and town and village centres to keep communities alive and sustain liveable communities.
- Transform the Tropicana and Birnbeck Pier into nationally recognised venues and attractions.
- Campaign for central government to reform business rates to help small enterprises establish themselves and thrive with ease
- Supporting High Streets and town and village centres to sustain liveable communities.

Environment, Transport, and Net Zero - Protecting the environment and reaching net zero by 2030

- Deliver North Somerset's Climate Change Action Plan to create a carbonneutral council and area by 2030.
- Support a public-private partnership to generate tidal electricity and create a micro-grid using renewable energy
- Plant more trees and flowers throughout the community to tackle air pollution
- Improve and repair roads and footpaths to encourage the use of sustainable transport such as cycling and walking, including delivery of the Pier-to-Pier Cycle Path, the Gordano Greenway, and the Strawberry Line extension to Wrington and Blagdon.
- Encourage environmentally friendly waste disposal by installing 100 more litter bins across North Somerset to tackle littering in our communities and running a district-wide spring clean every year to support volunteers, community groups and businesses who do their bit to keep North Somerset clean and green.
- Press the Environment Agency to improve flood defences and urban sustainable drainage

Housing - Providing high-quality, affordable housing for all residents

- Increase the rate of affordable homebuilding in North Somerset, building on our success in applying for Housing Infrastructure Funds.
- Target additional funding to improve home energy efficiency helping save residents money on heating bills.
- Support rough sleepers, the homeless, and those at risk of homelessness through a 'housing first' approach
- Undertake a review of council planning procedures and resources to restore credibility to the process and ensure that all planning applications are properly and effectively assessed and determined within eight weeks
- Introduce a North Somerset Wide Licensing Scheme to replicate the success of the Weston Central Licensing Scheme at improving the quality of housing stock in the private rental sector.
- Empowering Town and Parish Councils to develop neighbourhood plans that better represent North Somerset's Town & villages' ambitions and aspirations for future growth.



Investing in a safer North Somerset

North Somerset Liberal Democrats will help to deliver projects that make North Somerset a safer place to live, work and .

- The Liberal Democrats will invest in safer communities by expanding neighbourhood enforcement, establishing a Crime Prevention Fund for all wards, and securing Purple Flag accreditation for improved town centers.
- We will ensure that a Community Hub is in every ward, with funding available to support them to be sustained in the community.
- Additionally, we will invest in ward-level social prescribing to tackle loneliness and isolation, and work with partners to make our communities dementia friendly.
- Our priorities are to create safer, more connected, and supportive communities. We believe in investing in our neighbourhoods and providing resources to prevent crime and promote well-being. Vote for us to build a brighter future for our towns and villages.



Making North Somerset the best place to grow up

North Somerset Liberal Democrats will deliver better futures for our children and young people.

- To prioritize the safety of children and young people, we will create timed 20mph zones around all schools, supported by the 20's Plenty safety campaign.
- We will improve our special education needs and disabilities service by increasing Special Educations Needs and Disability, and Mental Health Capacity within North Somerset.
- We will invest in special educational needs and disabilities by building a new special school in North Somerset, improving assessments and support services.
- We will collaborate with mental health services to provide stronger CAMHS services for vulnerable children and young people.
- We will support children's centres and other early intervention services to give children the best start in life.
- Council Tax relief will be provided to foster carers and care leavers in their first year.
- We will make fair funding for schools a lobbying priority of the Council, advocating for more funding.



Delivering green and inclusive economic growth

North Somerset Liberal Democrats will help create local jobs and boost our economy.

- The Liberal Democrats are committed to delivering green and inclusive economic growth in North Somerset. Our focus is on developing Junction 21 of the M5 (West of England Enterprise Zone) and supporting economic development around the Portishead Line.
- We support a public-private partnership for tidal electricity generation along the River Severn, decarbonising council assets, investing in unlocking employment opportunities, continuing to support economic development around the Portishead Line, and attracting businesses through rate reductions.
- Our party will drive investment in towns across North Somerset to increase job opportunities for locals and expand the number of available apprenticeships and training opportunities.
- In addition, we will establish an independent destination management organization to promote and manage tourism in North Somerset, and we will introduce a new approach to parking.
- We will explore joining the West of England Combined Authority to benefit from enhanced central government funding and improve joint working with neighbouring councils.
- Our party is committed to encouraging council suppliers to pay their staff the real living wage. We will set an example to local employers by ensuring all council directly-employed staff are paid at least the real living wage.
- Furthermore, we will bring new life to the Tropicana by investing in transforming it into a conference and music venue that will support our visitor economy and tourism industry.
- We will campaign for the central government to reform business rates to help small enterprises establish themselves and thrive with ease.
- We will encourage the council and its directly contracted suppliers - to employ local people, create apprenticeships and contribute local value from all projects. We will seek to prioritise local North Somerset suppliers in contract awards where this is possible.



Protecting our environment

North Somerset Liberal Democrats will protect our environment and help to tackle climate change.

- The Liberal Democrats are dedicated to protecting the environment and delivering a carbon-neutral council and area by 2030. We believe that a healthy environment is fundamental to the well-being and prosperity of our community. Therefore, we are committed to taking action to ensure a greener and more sustainable future for all.
- One of our key commitments is to support a public-private partnership to generate tidal electricity and create a micro-grid using renewable energy. This will not only provide environmentally friendly energy but it will also create job opportunities and stimulate economic growth. We will work in conjunction with other authorities to ensure that the project is successful.
- We also pledge to prohibit the use of council land for fracking under any circumstances. Fracking is known to have significant environmental and health risks, and we believe that protecting our environment and public health is of utmost importance.  effect on the environment and community. To tackle these issues, we
 will create a new street environment service, giving it the funding
 and powers needed to reduce fly-tipping and enforce against illegal
 parking. This service will ensure that our community remains clean
 and free from pollution.
- We will plant a quarter of a million flower bulbs across our towns and villages. This will not only beautify our neighbourhoods but will also provide a habitat for bees and other pollinators that are essential to our ecosystem.
- Finally, we will press the Environment Agency to improve flood defences and urban sustainable drainage. Climate change has led to an increase in flooding in our community, and we believe that immediate action is necessary to protect our community from the impact of flooding.



Looking after your money and protecting frontline services

North Somerset Liberal Democrats will always remember it is your money and make sure that basic, frontline services are protected.

- Despite unfair funding from central government, North Somerset Liberal Democrats are committed to promoting openness, fairness, and greenness in Finance and Corporate Services. We prioritize social care and investing in frontline services to create a supportive environment for everyone. The Birnbeck Pier, located in Weston-super-Mare, is a Grade II-listed pier that has been closed since 1994. The pier has a rich history and is an integral part of the town's heritage. By restoring it, we aim to preserve a part of our past and promote tourism in the area.
- Similarly, the Tropicana, also located in Weston-super-Mare, is a former lido that has been closed since 2000. We plan to renovate this site and transform it into a modern leisure complex that will attract tourists from far and wide. This will not only provide visitors with a great experience, but it will also create job opportunities for the local community.
- Overall, by investing in these two sites, we hope to promote tourism, create jobs, and preserve important parts of our heritage for future generations to enjoy.
